

ADMINISTRATIVE TRAINING INSTITUTE, MYSORE

Administrative Training Institute the apex level training institute came into being in the year 1967. ATI is recognized by Govt. of India in the Department of Personnel and Training(DoPT) to shoulder it by conducting various training programmes. In addition to this, ATI has also been



recognized as a Regional Center by Election Commission of India for training Chief Electoral Officers of Southern India. Newly recruited probationers by Karnataka Public Service Commission (KPSC) to various departments will also undergo foundational training at ATI for a period of 6 weeks. IAS probationers allotted to Karnataka Cadre are trained at ATI



immediately after their first phase training at LBSNAA, Mussoorie, for 6 weeks. On a regular basis ATI conducts refresher courses on various issues *inter alia* Public Administration, Financial Management, Legal Aspects, Gender Issues, RTI etc. ATI also conducts E-Governance, Good Governance, Quality Management, Sevottam initiatives,

Management Development Programme (MDP) including Direct Trainers Skills (DTS) and Design of Training (DoT).

ADMINISTRATIVE SET-UP

ATI is headed by a Senior IAS Officer of the rank Principal Secretary to Govt. of Karnataka as Director General. DG is supported by Joint Director – (Administration) and Joint Director – (Training). In ATI, there are 8 Faculty Members in various disciplines like Public Administration, Financial Management, Law, Women Studies, RTI, Behavioural Science, E-Governance, Good Governance etc.

ABDUL NAZIR SAB STATE INSTITUTE OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (ANSSIRD) AND STATE INSTITUTE FOR URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SIUD)

ATI in its campus has 2 of its sister institutions viz., Abdul Nazir Sab State Institute of Rural Development (ANSSIRD) and State Institute of Urban Development (SIUD). Both these institutions are catering to the training requirements of Rural Development and Urban Development functionaries respectively.



ANSSIRD has a well set SATCOM center with a Network of Receiving Centers at all the Taluka levels, through which training programmes in satellite mode is given covering elected representatives en masse. ANSSIRD and SIUD are working under the direct control of Director General of ATI.

In-turn these two are headed by an Officer from Rural Development and Urban Development Departments as its Director.

CENTER FOR DISASTER MANAGEMENT (CDM)

“Center for Disaster Management (CDM)” has been functioning since 2007 in the ATI campus, meeting the demands on training needs on Disaster Management. The center also conducts training programmes sponsored by National Institute of Disaster Management (NIDM), New Delhi. The center is functioning with a full-fledged supporting staff.

DECENTRALIZED SETUP (DISTRICT LEVEL)

Under its aegis, ATI has 30 District Training Institutes (DTIs) spread across the entire state of Karnataka, functioning under the overall guidance and supervision of Director General, ATI.

ENVIRONMENT

ATI is situated on the Lalithamahahal Road – a prime road connecting various places more prominently which includes way to Chamundi Hill. The ATI’s boundary is running across the

Karanji Lake on one side, Karnataka State Armed Reserve Police in its front. Amidst its campus ATI is also adjoined by Sri Kanteerava Narasimharaja Sports Club – centenary one.

INFRASTRUCTURE:

The campus begins with twin heritage buildings which have a long traditional value housing Administrative block, Chambers of Director General, Visitor Room, Faculty Room etc.

HOSTEL BLOCK

The Institute has two Hostel blocks namely, Kapila and Kabini which accommodate 240 officers at a time. Each of the room in both hostel blocks is provided with a computer accessing to internet.



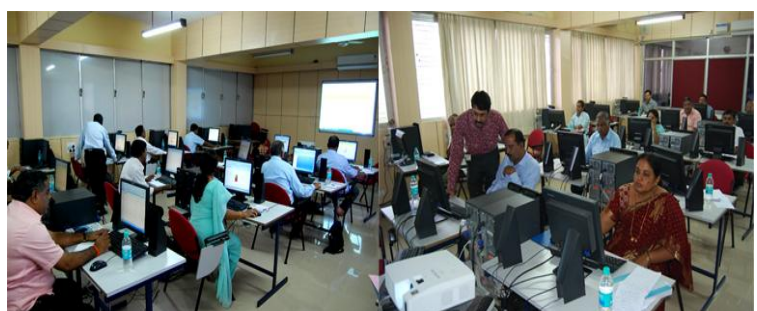
CLASS ROOMS



ATI has 10 class rooms with modern training facilities and a Conference Hall, a Seminar Hall, a Home Theatre, one Syndicate Room.

COMPUTER FACILITY

The institute has two Computer centers in its campus with 50 Computers connected by LAN.

The institutes has a well furnished library with a collection of more than 60000 books including reports, manuals, gazettes, journals, periodicals, magazines. Information of library are fully automated and available all the bibliographical data through Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) and networked (campus networking) resource sharing.

HOW TO REACH

Mysore is located at a distance of 150 KMs by road from Bangalore.

Mysore is well connected by road through buses and train.

Karnataka State Road Transport Corporation (KSRTC) Buses ply at a regular interval of every 20 minutes. Special Air-conditioner buses like Volvo, Raja-Hamsa, Vega-Dootha, Sheetal are ply at a regular interval of every hour.

Mysore Suburban Bus Station is 3.5 Km from ATI and Mysore Railway Station is 4.0 Km from ATI with 20 minutes drive from either Bus or Railway Station. Prepaid Autos are available at Railway Station / Suburban Bus station for reaching ATI, which costs around Rs.70/-.

- d) **Kaveri Express** leave Bangalore at 4:50AM and Arrives Mysore at 8:00AM
- e) **Tippu Express** leave Bangalore at 3.00PM and Arrives Mysore at 17:30PM
- f) **Yashwanthpur-Kannur Express** leave Bangalore at 8:55PM and Arrives Mysore at 11:30PM
- g) **Chamundhi Express** leave Bangalore at 18:15 PM and Arrives Mysore at 21:10PM



AIRPORT

Mysore Airport is 8.0 Km away from ATI with a 20 minutes drive. Air journey from Bangalore to Mysore is being operated by KingFisher Flights leaving Bangalore at 12.00 noon and arriving Mysore at 12.45PM and from Mysore will depart at 2.20 PM and 3.10 PM in Bangalore daily.
